**Transfers** - We offer transfer services for 1/4" and 1/2" analog 2-track tape, 1630 and cassette. We have one of the few operating 1630 machines in the region. If you have an CD master from a few years ago & can't find a replicator who will accept a 1630 master, we can help!

**Online Delivery** - We offer clients the ability to upload mixes as well as download references and other media using a unique account on our server. We can also deliver masters anywhere in the world digitally using the DDP format, a recommended standard format in the replication industry.

**Disc Duplication/Replication** - The Kitchen Mastering offers same day service on short runs (up to 100) of CDR's Monday through Friday during normal business hours. Larger CDR duplication runs can usually be accomodated within twenty-four to forty-eight hours.
